UCF'S INCLUSIVE EDUCATION SERVICES (IES) PROGRAM

UCF's Inclusive Education Services (IES) Program provides a comprehensive, non-degree-seeking college experience to adults with intellectual disabilities. During the two-year experience, students discover and develop their passions and strengths, enhancing their ability to facilitate long-term, paid and fulfilling employment after graduation.

The program strives to deliver an immersive, innovative and distinctive collegiate experience. Students live on campus and engage with other UCF students at sporting events and student organizations, as well as complete internships in the community. The goal is to prepare students to secure employment after graduation. The program is open to students between the ages of 18-30.

PUZZLE RANCH

Puzzle Ranch is a Wild West-themed ranch in Sorrento,FL, featuring a petting zoo, teepees, horseback riding, hay rides, hiking trails, bicycle riding, and a gemstone mining sluice. The grounds also house a western saloon, store, sheriff's office and jail. The ranch owners have children with autism and have taken special efforts to cater to children and adults with special needs, including days when families of children with special needs can come for free!

CENTRAL FLORIDA DREAMPLEX

To provide The Central Florida Dreamplex is a center for therapy, fitness, recreation, and sports designed specifically for individuals with physical and/or intellectual disabilities. Our programs include traditional and recreational therapies, adaptive sports, early learner education, out of school care, vocational rehab, and group fitness classes for the whole family.

Saturday, May 4 | 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.




TRANSPORTATION APPRECIATION!
