PTA HIGHLIGHTS


Our PTA now has 19 members (11 parents/guardians and 8 staff), and we thank you for joining! Not a member yet? Scan the QR code and join today!

OCA FIRST FLIGHT ACADEMY

First Flight Academy is the perfect way to continue education for persons 18 years or older with development disabilities. The program offers courses and credentialing opportunities with 75 hours of instruction for each cohort. Our first group started in March!

Course series will offer: Credential opportunity, Social skills training, Problem solving skills, Daily Living Skills support, Health and Nutrition education, Internship Placement, Job coach support.

Instruction will be provided by a certified teacher with wraparound supports from our clinical team (BCBA, BCaBA, and

At Buddy Break, VIP kids and their siblings make new friends, play games, do crafts, hear children's stories, enjoy music, and more! Meanwhile, parents get a break from their ongoing care-giving responsibilities, usually for three hours on a Friday night or Saturday morning.

KNOW YOUR HISTORY


