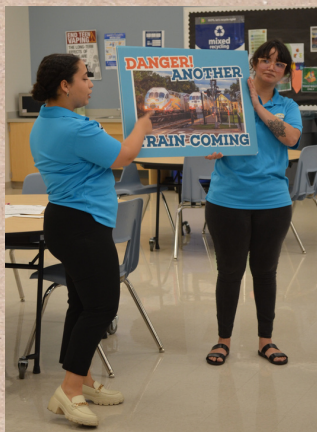
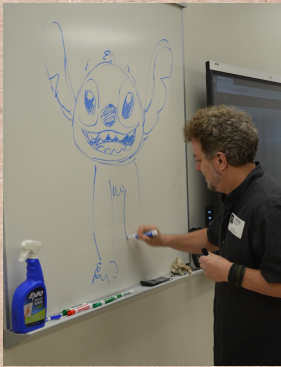

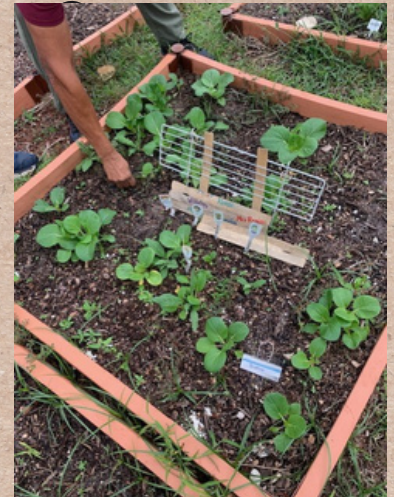




# SHOUTOUTS FROM THE STABLES
